

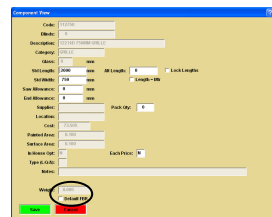
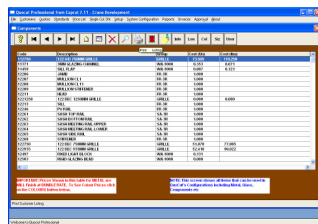
FULL BAR ROUNDUP

QuoCut Professional offers the functionality to include full bars (as opposed to actual length to be used) in the calculation of a quotation and a cost analysis. All calculations will automatically be recorded in Diary Notes. An additional note can be added to the Diary Note at the time of calculation or the user can manually add a Diary Note at any time. The program also has an option for individual extrusion to be set up as a default FBR. By defaulting individual items to FBR these items will automatically appear tagged ready when the FBR function is selected.

NOTE: The full bar roundup (FBR) calculation will not display on a printed quotation.

1. DEFAULTING TO FULL BAR ROUNDUP (FBR)

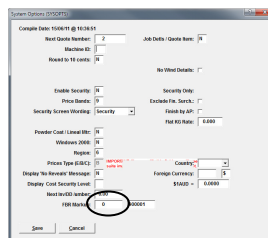
- Select Setup | Components
- Search by code for relevant extrusion and select View/Update
- Select Default FBR and **SAVE**



2. SETTING UP A DEFAULT % FBR MARKUP

- Select System Configuration | System Options
- Insert your default % FBR markup as appropriate (see note below) and **SAVE**

NOTE: It is not mandatory to have a % FBR markup – it is an individual choice as to whether the FBR amount is marked up or included in the calculation as a cost only. The user also has the option to change this % FBR markup at the time of calculation.

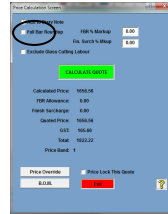
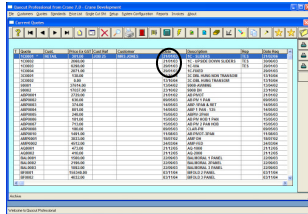


3. USING FULL BAR ROUNDUP (FBR) IN CALCULATION

QUOTATION CALCULATION

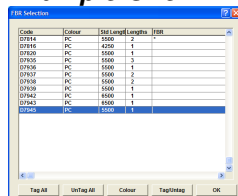
- Select Quotes | Current
- Highlight your quotation and select the calculation button
- Select Full Bar Roundup

FULL BAR ROUNDUP

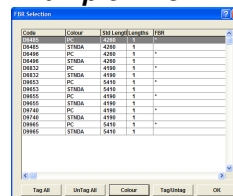


- Note – other options include the following:
 - Option to change the FBR % Markup as required
 - Select 'Add to Diary Notes' if a notation re the calculation is required
- Select Calculate Quote and the system will generate the FBR selection screen

NOTE: If the user has defaulted an item to FBR in the Component setup screen then this item will automatically appear as tagged.

- At this point in the process the user has the option to do the following:
 - Tag individual items for FBR calculation or tag all items (Example One)
 - Untag individual items or all items
 - Highlight an individual colour and select colour to only tag the one colour pricing group (Example Two)
- The calculation process will display the total cost and the amount of the FBR allowance for the user's information but **DOES NOT PRINT on the quotation.**

NOTE: If FBR has been selected when calculating a quotation, when printing the quotation, the option to 'show individual prices' will not be available.

COST ANALYSIS CALCULATION

- Select Quotes | Current and select cost Analysis
- Select 'Add to Diary Notes' if a notation in relation to the costing is required
- Select Preview if desired and then select continue
- The cost analysis displays a separate item showing the actual cost of the FBR.
